

Valentine's Day Chocolate Oreos



Ingredients

- 24 Oreos
- · 16 ounces semisweet white chocolate disks
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon extract
- heart sprinkles for decoration

Instructions

- Melt the white chocolate in the microwave, stirring between 30 second increments. Stir in cinnamon extract.
- Use a fork to dip the Oreos in the chocolate, scraping the excess chocolate off the fork. Place the Oreos on parchment paper to harden.
- Use the rest of the chocolate in a piping bag, squeezing over the Oreos, then topping with heart sprinkles. Let the Oreos rest until fully hardened.

PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION


Many people are concerned about someone stealing their credit card, check or debit card numbers, but they may be ignoring one easy way thieves can access financial accounts...**receipts**. Disregarding receipts containing valuable information greatly increases the risk of credit and debit card fraud. Thieves can easily copy valid account numbers from receipts found in trash cans, and use that information to wreak havoc on your identity and finances.

Take the easy steps below to help prevent thieves from using receipts to access your information:

- Do not leave gasoline credit card receipts at the pump, as they may contain your credit card number.
- Shred all credit and debit card receipts, pre-approved credit offers, insurance forms, financial statements and other paperwork containing personal and financial information.
- Check credit union statements and other financial statements monthly for discrepancies; retain copies of purchase receipts to check against your statement.
- Order a credit report once a year to make sure no one else is using your personal information to obtain credit cards or services.




Deposit a Check Anywhere with Remote Deposit!
